ACCOUNTABILITY

The Choir School Accompanist is accountable to the Session through the Personnel Committee and serves under the direction of the director of the ensemble, the Director of Music Education and Outreach, the Director of Music and Fine Arts and the Senior Pastor of Second Presbyterian Church.

PERSONAL QUALIFICATIONS

- Holds and demonstrates Christian values and is comfortable sharing their Christian faith with children and adults.
- Is highly creative and passionate about working with children and/or youth.
- Possesses the ability to work effectively as a member of a large staff.
- Exhibits excellent planning, organizational and communication skills.

PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

Minimum requirements:

- Proficient piano technique.
- Ability to sightread and play choral parts as needed.
- Ability to polish accompaniments to be performed in services or concerts.
- Ability to follow the director of the ensemble with ease and support their spiritual, musical and artistic goals.
- Experience working in a church setting preferred.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The Choir School Accompanist is a part-time position, and has the following responsibilities:

- *Education*
 - Engender, encourage and demonstrate by example a love of God, a love of church, and a love for music as a means of public worship and private devotion.
 - Assist the Director of Music Education and Outreach in educating the parents, church staff and congregation as to the purpose, power and meaning of a Children's Music Ministry.
- *Musicianship*
 - Accompany the assigned ensemble, including in rehearsal, worship and performance as needed.
- *Administration*
 - Meet periodically with the Choir Director, the Director of Music Education and Outreach and the Children's Music Advisory Team.
 - Meet as needed with the Music and Fine Arts Ministry Team, and the Children and Families Ministry Team.
 - Perform other duties as assigned.
